# Principal - Mrs. Libby

- School updates:
  - The PM2 is going on. (Progress Monitoring test #2 for midyear) This data is to help with planning lessons that may need to be retaught and gives a snapshot of academic growth when compared to PM1.
  - There are district funds for ELP tutoring for 3rd 5th graders who are in the bottom quartile.
  - Mrs. Corriell is one of five finalists out of 14,000 teachers in the district that is up for teacher of the year. There will be a program called Excellence in Education at the Straz Center on Jan. 23 from 4:30-7pm at which time the winner will be announced. Tickets are \$25. Students will be reading something they'd written about their teachers.
  - Students who are struggling academically from any income bracket are eligible for \$500 worth of tutoring accessible from the STEP UP program.
  - There is a free training available for teachers from the Reed Charitable Foundation that educates teachers on multi-sensory teaching strategies.
    Mrs. Libby will see if teachers are interested in the training and apply to have the hours put towards the reading endorsement requirement.
